Type Reset to SV3 Instructions: SV-3



Overview

Unfortunately, like all computers, a spa controller can boot up incorrectly, causing pumps and other components to function incorrectly or not at all. A 'Type Reset' is the equivalent to restarting a computer - it will reboot the controller, allowing it to reconnect correctly and restore function as designed. If you run into any issues during this process, contact our friendly customer care team at Alpine Spas for assistance.

Step 1.

Press and hold the **PUMP B + BLOWER + CLEAN buttons** at the same time until 'bRNd' appears on the display.



Step 2.

Press the **UP button** until the 'TYPE' menu option appears on the display.



Step 3.

Press the **OK button** to enter the TYPE setting adjustment => the display will show 'SM1'

Step 4.

Press the **DOWN button** until display shows **'SV3'**



Step 5.

Press the **OK button** to save the type as 'SV3' => the display will return to 'TYPE'



Step 6.

Press the **UP button** until display shows 'BOOT'



Step 7.

Press the **OK button** to initiate the reset and reboot the system. The screen will display SPANET SV3 and then show PRIMING confirming the type reset was successful.

Step 8.

The final step is to turn your spa OFF for 10 seconds then back ON again to complete the process. Your spa should now function as intended with normal operation and button function restored.
